



Entrance Testing Requirements

To enter UMW's College of Education you must...

Pass entrance assessments via **one** of the following options:

- I. Option #1: SAT as a substitute test for Praxis Core
 - SAT taken On or After March 1, 2016- a total score of 1170 with at least 580 on Evidence-Based Reading and Writing Section and 560 on Math
- II. Option #2: ACT as a Substitute Test for Praxis Core
 - ACT taken After April 1, 1995- Composite score of 24 with ACT Math score no less than 22 and an ACT English Plus Reading score no less than 46
- III. Option #3 VCLA+ Math Assessment
 - VCLA cumulative score of 470 (reading and writing) + Praxis Core Math (Test Code: 5732 OR 5733) score of at least 150
 - OR**
 - VCLA + SAT Math of at least 560 (after March 1, 2016)
 - OR**
 - VCLA+ ACT Math of at least 22
