

Entrance Testing Requirements

To be admitted to UMW's College of Education you must submit passing scores for a reading/writing assessment. You may select one from the list below.

Reading/Writing Assessments:

- SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing Section score of at least 580 (as of March 1, 2016) or
- SAT Verbal score of at least 530 (between April 1, 1995 and March 1, 2016) or
- ACT English Plus Reading score of at least 46 (after April 1, 1995) or
- VCLA cumulative score of at least 470 (reading and writing).

If you qualify for the substitute and did not submit ACT or SAT scores to UMW when you applied, you **MUST** request official ACT or SAT scores and have them sent to UMW (SAT CEEB 5398; ACT 4414)
